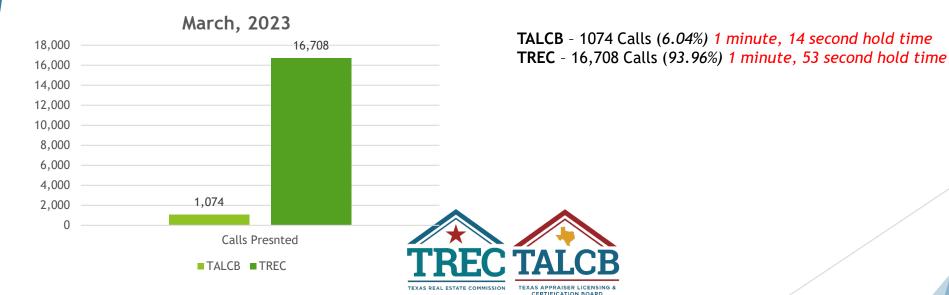
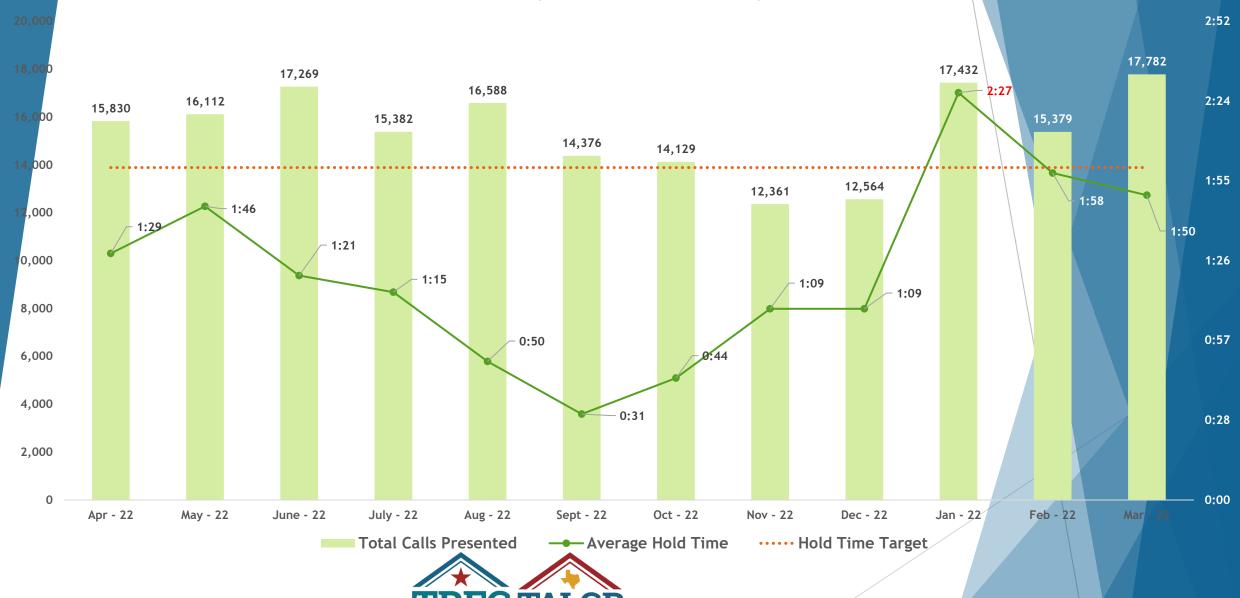

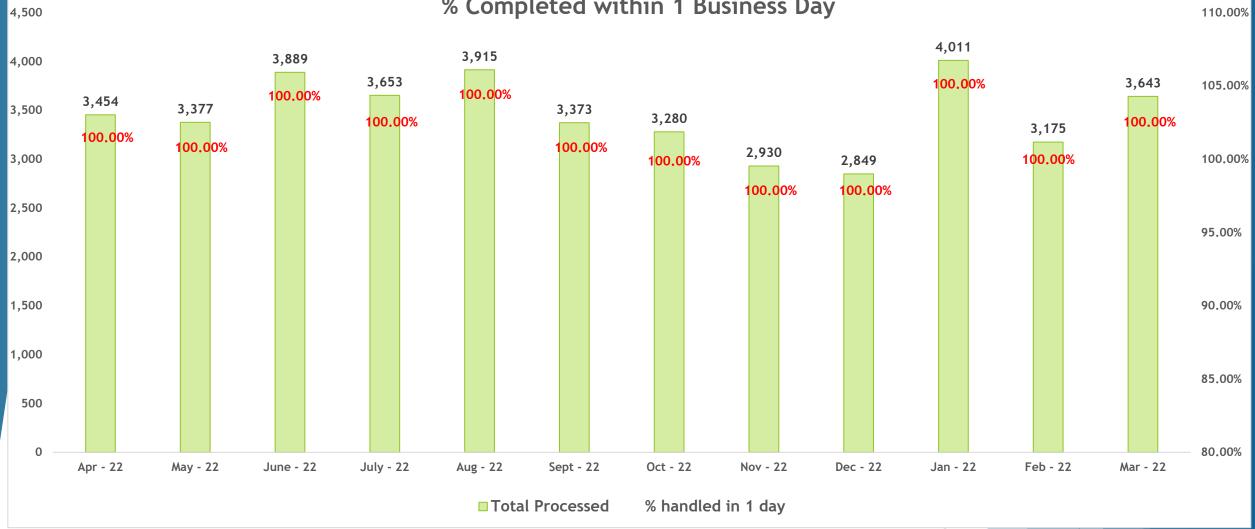


### Last 12 Months: Calls Presented vs. Hold Time



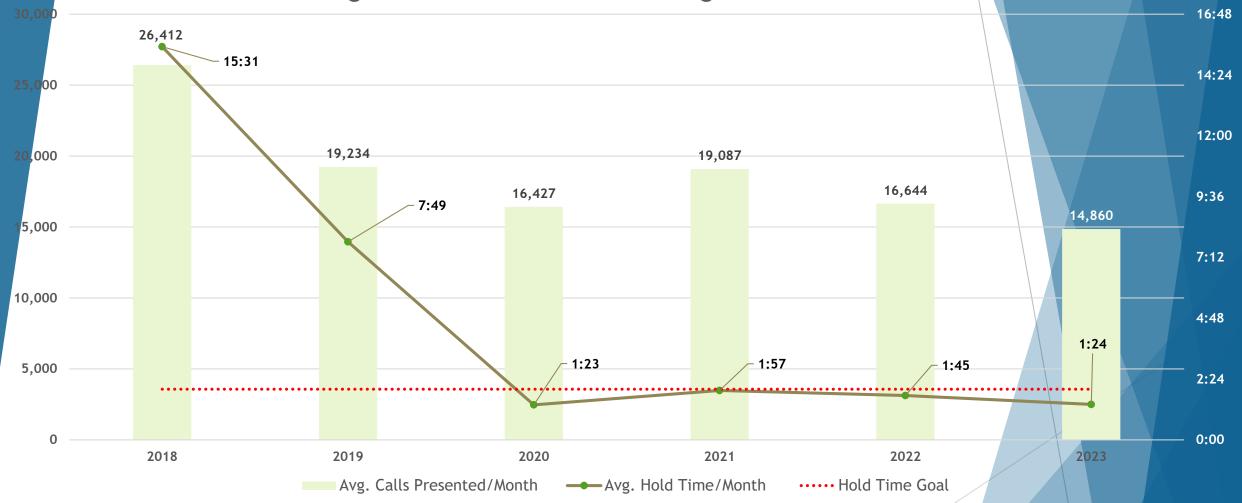

## All TREC Applications Approved Year-Over-Year Comparison

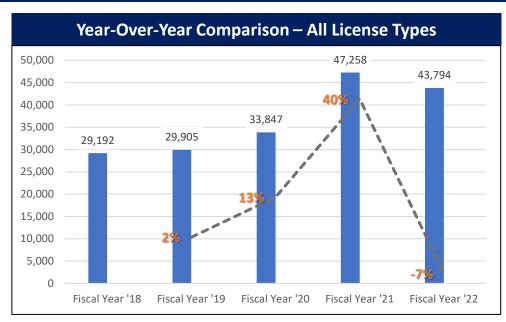


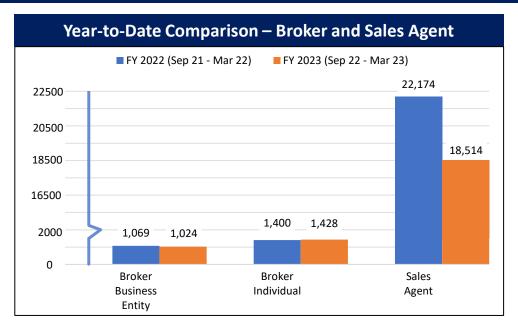
